WHY STUDY THE PROPHETS?

1. They're in the Word of God.

God chose to reveal Himself to us in 66 books, 17 of which (26%) are in the section we now call "the Prophets." That reason alone should give us motivation to study them.

2. They teach us about God and His people.

We struggle with the same sins today as the people of Judah and Israel did back then, and we answer to the same God. We can learn from their mistakes.

3. They help us understand the context of the New Testament.

There is so much more to the Prophets than just Messianic predictions (though there are certainly plenty of those too). The struggles of God's people in the Prophets helped shape the culture of the NT.

4. They prepare us for what God is planning to do in the future.

Revelation isn't the only book that talks about the End Times. (In fact, most of Revelation is alluding to OT prophecies.) All because we call the OT the "*Old*" Testament doesn't mean it's irrelevant today.






